BLACK

Sadie gets up to see what the noise was. Still nervous from her nightmare, she walks slowly towards the door. The floor creaks.

INT. HALLWAY - CONTINUOUS

Sadie quickly walks out of her bedroom and into the dark hallway. She looks around and notices the light in her father's office is turned on.

She approaches the door slowly, trying not to make any sound. Sadie hears mumbling coming from the office.

She approaches the door and almost leans on it to hear the conversation.

CHARLIE

What?

SADIE

What happened? That call sounded serious.

CHARLIE

It's nothing, just work stuff. Don't worry about it. Everything will be better by tomorrow, trust me.

Sadie approaches her father and hugs him. Charlie smiles. At the same time, she is looking around the office, searching for his coat which contains the key to the door.

Sadie finds the coat on the coat hanger in the corner of the office. Bingo.

Sadie loosens her arms and ends the hug. Charlie kisses her forehead.

CHARLIE (cont'd)

Go back to bed. It's late.

Sadie turns and walks out of the office.

INT. HALLWAY - CONTINUOUS
